BE SURE TO INCLUDE YOUR FIRST AND LAST NAME IN THE EMAIL

This is something that you only get to do once in your life, so it's certainly a good idea to put some extra thought, care and attention into it. Inappropriate content will result in your submission being discarded. This, or failure to submit the form in a timely manner, will mean that admin staff will create a generic (therefore boring!) statement about you.

- 1. Matthew has enjoyed his time at ADSS and would like to thank his friends and family for their support throughout the years. He is currently attending his first year at North Island College in the Electrical Foundation program and would like to pursue a career as a Powerline Technician.
- 2. Sarah enjoyed her five years at ADSS, her fondest memories included being in several high school sports, her experiences in French immersion and making the Yearbook in her senior years. Sarah would like to thank her family and friends that helped her from day one to get where she is today.
- 3. During their time at ADSS, Pat really enjoyed participating in sports such as basketball and track & field. They would like to thank their parents for their endless support, and for being their #1 fans. Finally, they would like to thank their coaches, Ryan B, Mr. Bill, and Mrs. Jack for their mentorship.
