LOCKERS



- All ministry numeracy and literacy assessments are complete
- All fees must be paid. Outstanding library and textbooks returned

GRAD FAQ's

- Cap & Gowns and Tickets can be picked up during the first half of lunch this Wednesday and Thursday outside of the Theatre. After these dates, they can be picked up in the advising office.
- On the day of your graduation ceremony, guests will enter through the theatre doors. Doors open 1 hour before the ceremony. **All seats are assigned**
